West said undergraduates generally need to take three credit hours during the summer for part-time status.

 File a Financial Aid form before March 31 to speed up delivery of money.

Summer school students who have submitted a 1985-86 FAF or a form for the 1986 fall semester don't need to fill out another FAF, West said.

But, West said, students who plan to dow 5. attend only the summer pre-session are ineligible for GSLs.






