nudes in alcoves and behind balustrades, borders and crosses, accentuating them with odd architectural configurations. The architecture either serves to intimidate the figure or to intensify the beauty of the form. Bent limbs block or flow into complicated compositional lines.

This exhibit is a remarkable blend of idiosyncrasy and tradition that should convince most viewers that the area is not, in fact, a cultural wasteland. The artists involved have definite styles and show a tremendous confidence in the uniqueness of those styles.

Here's how!

Q How does the University Bookstore determine how much my books are worth when I sell them back?

A If the bookstore has been notified that the book is to be re-adopted for the next semester, and if the bookstore does not already have a sufficient stock on hand, then the student will be offered 60% of the publisher's current list price. For instance, a book which currently sells for \$20.00 new, and which meets the requirements noted above would be worth \$12.00. The exception would be English paperbacks which will be bought at wholesale prices.

If the book will not be used again, or if the Bookstore has a sufficient stock, the book would be worth the current wholesale price as indicated by one of the nation's largest jobbers of used textbooks.

Q Is sixty percent the usual price paid for textbooks around the country?

A Definitely not! Most stores in the United States pay only 50 percent for books being used again. The University Bookstore is one of only a few which pays 60 percent. And remember we pay cash and we pay 60% of the current list price.

Remember, bring us your books during Finals Week. Books will be bought April 30-May 9, 8:30-4:30 at North Union Main Lounge and 9:00-4:00 at East Union Bookstore.
