The center's staff has experience in industrial engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, data analyses and public services.

Staff members make referrals to other departments within the university and to such agencies as the Nebraska Business Development Centers, Food Processing Center and the Nebraska Investment Finance Authority.

One NTAC staff member is an ombudsman/liason from the Nebraska Department of Economic Development who hooks up eligible clients with DED programs and grants. NTAC staff travel the state to manufacturing sites and companies to find out where they can be of assistance.

Riley said the center often fills the gap between what a company can do and what it is willing to pay a consultant to provide an answer.
