It also explores his extraordinary arranger Gil Evans on such classic The 60-minute performance/docu- record albums as "Sketches of Spain" and his intuitive genius as a bandleader. He sought out and nurtured the young, innovative leaders of successive generations - such as John Coltrane, Wayne Shorter and Herbie Hancock forging their emerging talent into a continual series of new sounds and catapulting them into their own stardom.

The series' premiere program feature focuses on the education of Afghan refugees living in Pakistan. UNO and its Afghan Studies staff was awarded an educational aid grant to promote Afghan education.






