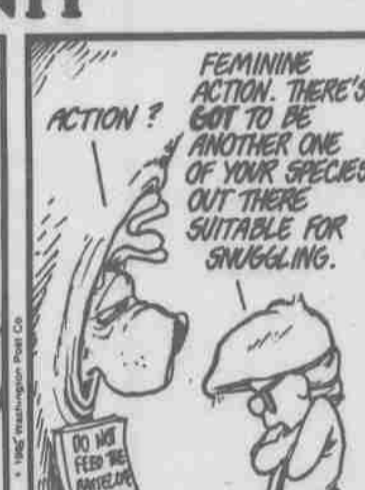

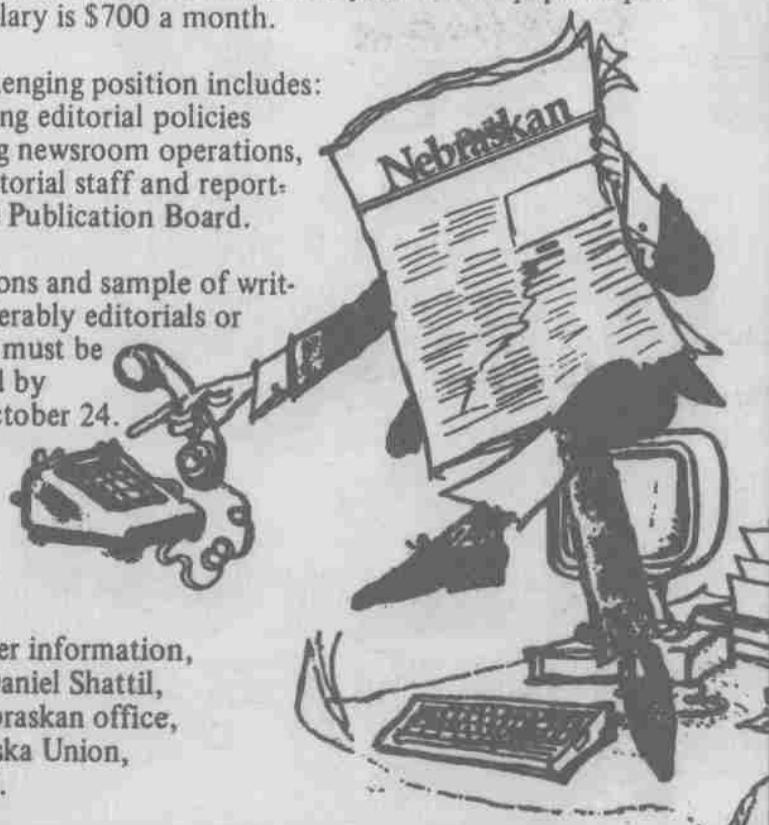


Wanted: Editor in Chief
