"Both times the ball was involved, and it was reaching," Nee said. "How he distinguishes those from the other 50,000 fouls called in a game is beyond me."

Swain hit all six technical shots, and Creighton ran out the clock for the victory.

Nebraska was led by Bernard Day, who scored 17 points. Day said that Creighton didn't pull any surprises.

"They did what we expected," Day

said. "We could have done a lot better than what we did, inside and outside."

Anthony Bailous and Joel Sealer each scored 15 for Nebraska, and Bill Jackman pulled down 11 rebounds to lead both teams.

Brian Carr would up with only three points on the night — 15 points below his season average.

"Every time down, there was a man always following me," Carr said. "At the beginning of the game, not as much as the end, they made sure somebody

was on me all the time."

It was Creighton's first victory over Nebraska since 1980, pushing the Bluejays to 2-0 on the season. The Huskers fell to 1-2. The two teams square off again on Jan. 3 in Lincoln. Carr said he's looking forward to that.

"I can't wait for January 3," he said. "It's upsetting to lose a game like this, but you have to give them credit. We let them shoot that three-point shot and they just happened to knock them down."
