

Auditions this week for feminist satire

Auditions for Sarah Daniels' "Ripen Our Darkness" will be Wednesday through Friday in Temple Building 16.

"Ripen Our Darkness" is a combination of social comment and biting humor in an irreverent portrait of wives and daughters battling the absurdities and oppressiveness of male domination. Daniels' feminist satire focuses on a middle-aged housewife whose life of drudgery drives her to suicide and a celestial meeting with the feminist trinity.

En route, she successfully fights off her husband's attempt to commit her for psychiatric care and comes to terms with her daughter's lesbianism.

The play offers a number of roles for women and men ages 20 to 60. Auditions are open to all members of the Lincoln community and no preparation is necessary.
