



DeBoer set to lead NU volleyball team

Last year, Nebraska's volleyball team was led by three All-America performers: Karen Dahlgren, Tisha Delaney and

Enid Schonewise. Because all three players graduated, senior Kathi DeBoer said she expects

to be counted on as the team's leader. 'Each year your role changes for one reason or another," DeBoer said. "Being the only senior, I need to help others out more this season.'

Nebraska volleyball coach Terry Pettit also said DeBoer has a new role.

'She will be our strongest left-side attacker, so she will have quite a few balls set for her this season," Pettit said. "She is also an excellent blocker and defender.'

DeBoer was a starter on last year's NCAA runner-up team that finished 29-6. She earned NCAA Mideast Region all-tournament team and second-team all-Big Eight honors.
