Sippel, a senior from Stratford, Ontario, has spiced her college career by receiving both gold and bronze medals in international softball competition. She earned a bronze medal while competing for Canada in the 1987 Pan American Games in Indianapolis and earned a gold medal while she was a member of the 1983 Canadian team that participated in the Pan American Games in Caracas, Venezuela


