Japanese Oscar winner included in film lineup

The 1972 film "Dear Summer Sister," directed by Nagisa Oshima, will play on Feb. 4. The color movie follows Oshima, a Tokyo teen-ager, to Okinawa, where she searches for a half-brother she has never met. There, her exploration of the island turns into a complex discussion of incest, the guilt of war survivors and the "family" relationship between Okinawa and Japan.

"The Ballad of Narayama," directed by Shohei Imamura, will be shown Feb. 11. The 1983 movie is based on a Japanese legend. In an isolated, impoverished village, elders reaching the age of 70 are customarily abandoned on a mountain top to meet the gods of Narayama. Orin, a matriarch who is approaching 70, must save her family while stolen crops and newborns add to the various problems. She overcomes these adversities, but still insists that her reluctant son take her to Narayama.

"The Ballad of Narayama" won the Grand Prize at the 1983 Cannes Film Festival.

The final film in the series is on Feb. 18. "The Family Game," directed by Yoshimitsu Morita, is a comedy about a boy who has gone through many tutors, but finally meets his match in a tutor who keeps him off balance, ridicules him and sometimes slaps him around.

According to a New York Times reviewer, the film is not always easy to follow, but is almost always funny.

The film won the Japanese Oscar for best picture in 1983.
