The 1972 film "Dear Summer Sister," directed by Nagisa Oshima, will play on Feb. 4. The color movie follows Oshima, a Tokyo teen-ager, to Okinawa, where she searches for a half-brother she has never met. There, her exploration of the island turns into a complex discussion of in-cest, the guilt of war survivors and the "family" relationship between

Okinawa and Japan.
"The Ballad of Narayama," directed by Shohei Imamura, will be shown Feb. 11. The 1983 movie is based on a Japanese legend. In an isolated, impoverished village, elders reaching the age of 70 are customarily abandoned on a mountain top to meet the gods of Narayama. Orin, a matriarch who is approaching 70, must save her Oscar for best picture in 1983.
