Braatz said McBride, who joined

Bay. He also said the Packers would need permission to talk with McBride before contacting him. "First, we would call (Nebraska coach) Tom Osborne and ask him if we could talk to his assistant," Braatz said. "We have not done that, and see no reason for it, because we don't
have a coach."

Braatz said Green Bay is in the process of looking for a coach. Michigan State football coach George Perles was offered the job last month but turned it down.
McBride spent six years at Wisconsin before joining Osborne's staff. He served as an assistant coach toFrank Kush at Arizona State before that.
