Set your new home in order. -Confirm honeymoon reservations.

One week before the wed-

-Finalize all details with caterer, musicians, florist, baker, photographer and limousine service.

-Tell your attendants the date and time of the rehearsal and dinner.

-Inform the best man and matron of honor of any special responsibilities. —Check to see that attendants' wedding attire is satisfactory.

-Prepare the wedding announcements for mailing on wedding day.

—Start packing for your honey-

-Have the bachelor and bridesmaids parties.

On your wedding day:

-Give the best man the officiant's fee for delivery after the ceremony.

Remember to bring the wedding rings and the marriage license to the ceremony with you.

-Relax and enjoy.

For the groom:

Six months before the wed-

Pick up the bride's engagement ring from the jewelry store.

Arrange a visit with clergy member, justice of the peace or judge to discuss the ceremony.

Discuss with the bride how many ushers you'll need and select them.

-Discuss honeymoon plans with the bride. Consult a travel agent for

-If you will be traveling abroad, update your passport, arrange for visas and international drivers license, if needed, and check on inocu-

-Visit wedding gift registry with the

Three months before the wedding:

-Complete the guest list. Give it to the bride.

-Arrange transportation for the wedding party to the ceremony and

Complete honeymoon plans. Buy tickets.

Arrange to pay for the bride's bouquet, boutonnieres for the men in the wedding party and corsages for the mothers if desired.

—Buy presents for the bride and wedding participants.

One month before the wed-

-Consult with the bride to arrange lodging for relatives and ushers from out of town.

Select gifts for the groomsmen. -Make sure all necessary documents-legal, medical and religious

are in order.

-Check on arrangements for the bachelor party, if you are giving it.

-Pick up wedding ring for engrav-Help bride with wedding an-

nouncements and thank-you notes. -Arrange with the best man for transportation from the reception to the airport or wherever you plan to leave on your honeymoon.

-Double-check honeymoon reservations.

One week before the wedding:

-Explain any special seating arrangements for family or disabled guests to the head usher.


-Put the officiant's fee in an envelope and give it to the best man, who will deliver it after the ceremony.
