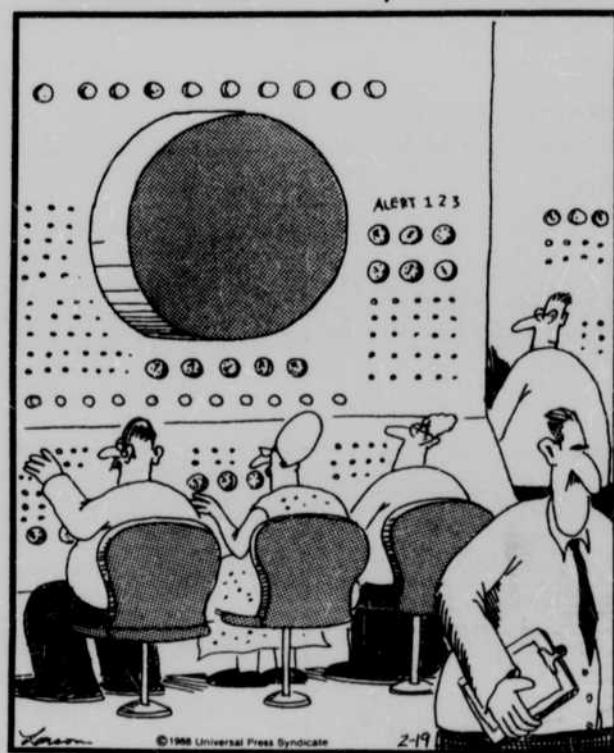

CROSSWORD PUZZLE

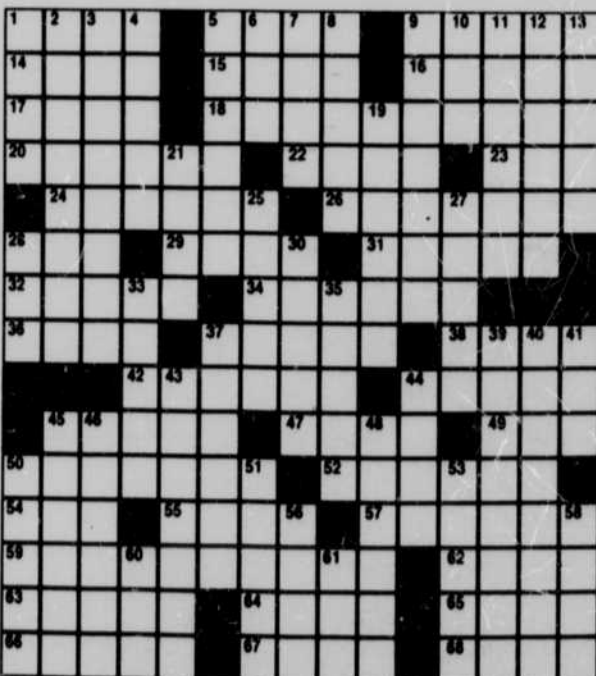
