

"Moon-struck" and "Broadcast News" are nice comedies. But if the Academy's whims go for grander subjects, "Hope and Glory" stands a very good

chance of winning.
Phillipe Rousselot's cinematography also stands well in its Oscar category, comparing favorably with both "The Last Emperor" and "Empire of the Sun." Again, its chances depend on whether the Academy likes its low-key beauty or the flash and heroics of Spielberg and cinematographer Allen Daviau.




