Recently the Nighthawks released a "Live In Europe" album on Varrick/Rounder Records, showcasing them at their live best.

Skyline's last show at the Zoo was supposed to be its last, but a change of heart among the band members has kept the group together so far.

Skyline is considered a strong force in progressive acoustic music today. The folk movement is blooming at a point unseen since the early 1960s, and Trischka's banjo playing will help you understand why.




