The drama of Len, an essentially good man struggling to understand the world and the people around him, is complicated by his failures.

From the simple act of getting a job to the difficult feat of forming a

romantic relationship, nothing Len does succeeds.

He falls in love with Pam after she picks him up for a one-night stand, and she seems to reciprocate his feelings. He moves in with her and her parents and plans to marry her. But Pam tires of him and finds a new lover, Fred, who sees her as little more than a one-night stand.

In "Saved," Bond presents a scathing view of contemporary society — a society where people lose their humanity with all too much ease.

Samuel Wolfgang Schimek directs the play. Deirdre Dorscher designed the costumes. And David Blenderman directs the lighting.

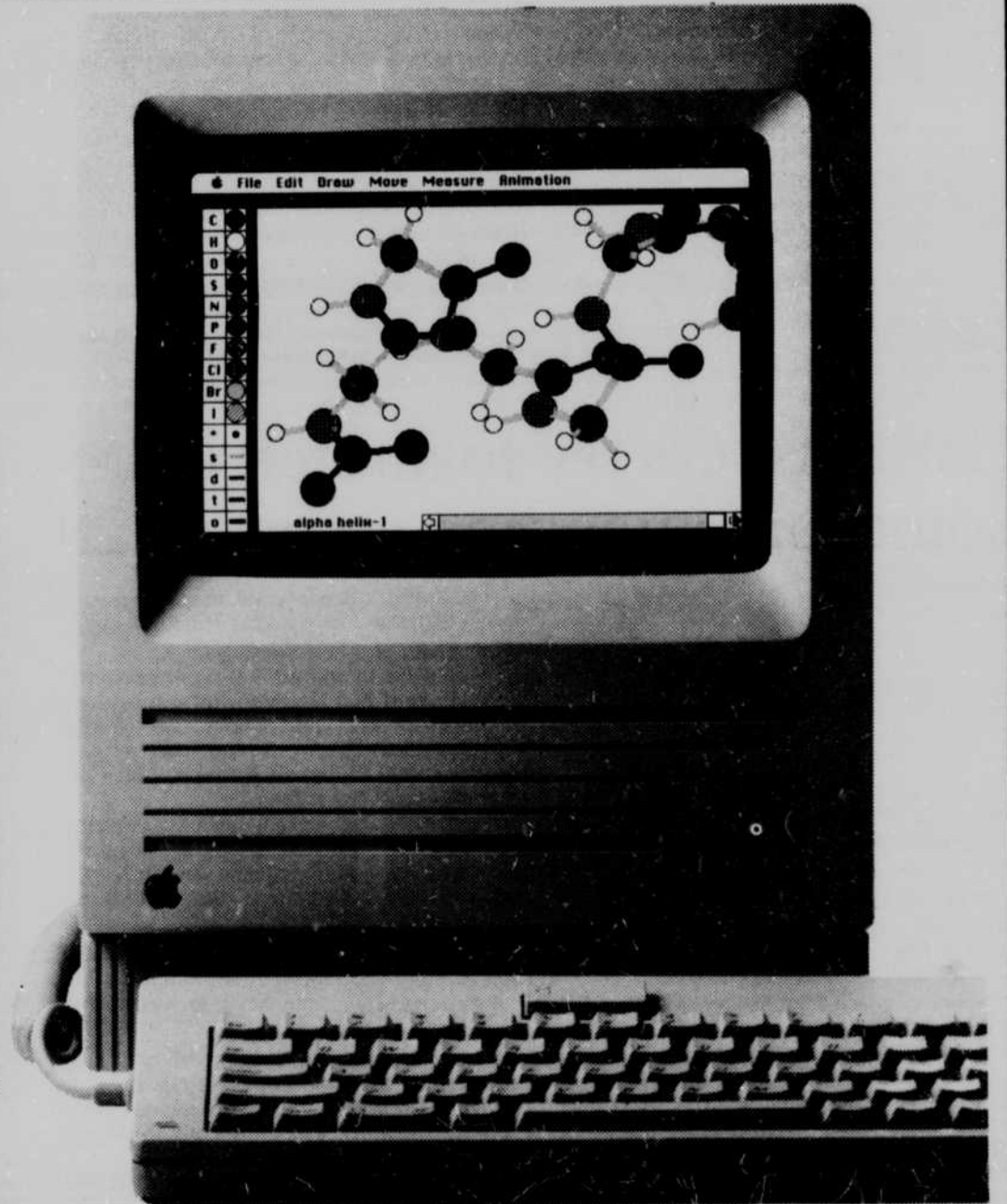
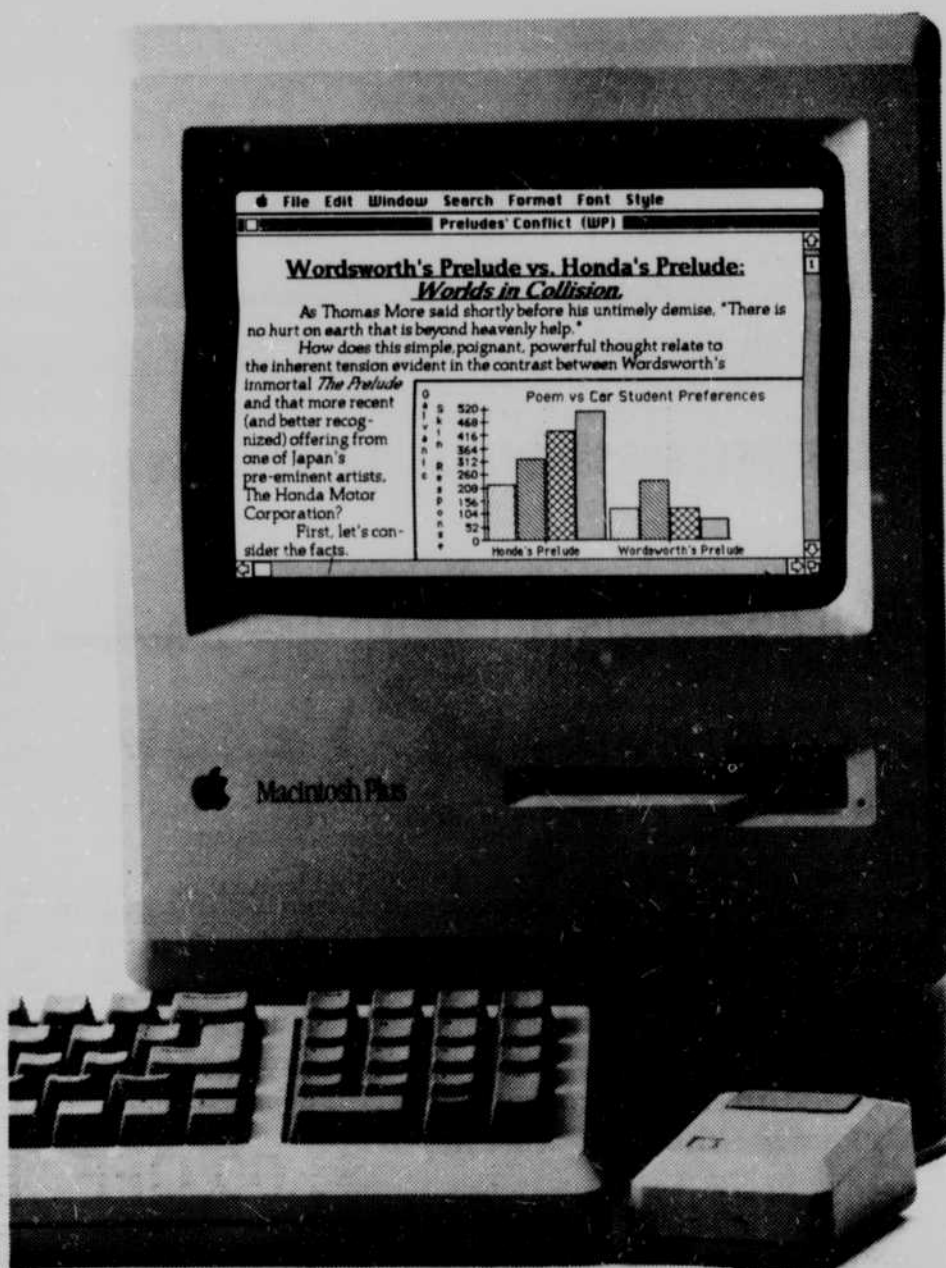
