Beadell's "Timesweep" was performed with three horns; Dennis Schneider on trumpet, Allen French on French horn, and Vernon Forbes on trombone. The piece begins with almost fanfare, then mellows into a more reflective mood. Schneider's trumpet was often dominant in the piece.

More of Beadell's work will be performed during the Faculty Composers recital Nov. 17.

The Moran Woodwind Quintet was simply fantastic. The group blended with each other, and sounded like different aspects of one instrument.

Named after the late John Moran, the quintet consists of John Bailey, flute; William McMullen, oboe; Anthony Pasquale, clarinet; Allen French, French horn; and Gary Echols, bassoon.

The quintet will play March 16 at Kimball.

Harvey Hinshaw performed the last three "Goldberg Variations" by J.S. Bach on harpsichord. Remember what Lurch played on the old "Adams Family" TV show? The music is still spooky, yet quite charming.

Hinshaw's recital is Feb. 9 at the Wick Center.
