'Ringers' gets a gong for tastelessness

"Dead Ringers" is now being advertised as a "thriller" by producer and director David Cronenberg, our good friend who grossed us out with his remake of "The Fly."

In this poor excuse for a flick, Jeremy Lyons stars as two twins who are completely batty. The first twin is

Beverly Mantle, the introverted scholar who works hard and is shy with women. Then there's Elliot Mantle, the confident stud who manages the brothers' careers.

The boys are gynecologists. Well-known in the world of medicine, they are called simply "the Mantle twins." The twins do have separate personalities, but they are very close. They live together in an apartment. They take turns sleeping with the same women.

However, things backfire when Claire Niveau, an actress who has been lured into the twins' love trap, figures out that she's romping with two different guys.

Niveau falls for Beverly, and tries to take him away from Elliot, because she sees the strange closeness that the twins have. She also gets him hooked on pills.

Elliot becomes worried when Bev gets messed up all the time, because Bev does some weird things.

Beverly is losing it and decides he has to have some special gynecological instruments designed for "mutant women." Oh boy. They are not very pleasant instruments to look at, let alone think about using.

The movie gets fairly disgusting by this point, and even girls in the back row started groaning. Oh boy.

Well, the medical world has found out that Bev has a problem with drugs by now, and has pretty much given

him the boot. Elliot tries to salvage their careers, but to no avail. So, he starts taking pills, too.

The twins become synchronized. They are now pill-popping, staggering gynecologist buddies from the Satanic underworld. Bev decides it's time for them to separate and gets radical with his mutant instruments.

By this time, several people have left the theater, and a few in the front are throwing popcorn. To tell the truth, this is a lot more interesting than the movie.
