

Luvisi to temporarily join Lincoln Orchestra

Internationally acclaimed pianist Lee Luvisi will be the guest soloist for the Lincoln Symphony Orchestra Tuesday at 8 p.m. Luvisi has developed his career as soloist and chamber musician quickly but steadily over the past

several decades. Today, he is a prominent artist on the American music scene.

Upon graduation, Luvisi became the youngest faculty member in the history of the Curtis Institute.

In 1963, Luvisi moved to Louisville, Ky., where he assumed the

position of artist in residence at the University of Louisville School of Music. He is now head of the piano department there.

Luvisi has had several solo appearances with orchestras across the United States, Canada, Mexico and Europe. He has performed under conductors such as

Bernstein, Ormandy and Steinberg.

Tuesday's program will be in Nebraska Wesleyan University's O'Donnell Auditorium. The concert will include "Piano Concerto No. 2" by Johannes Brahms and Bela Bartok's "Concerto for Orchestra."

Lincoln Symphony Orchestra's music director, Robert Emile, will conduct.

A pre-concert introduction will begin at 7:30 p.m.

Tickets for the concert are \$18, \$15, \$10 and \$8. Student tickets will be available for \$4, 30 minutes before the performance.


