pieces for the upcoming performance of "Generalities."

"Generalities," a program in which performers will take an in-depth look at gender myths, is one of many opportunities students involved in the department will have to perform throughout the year, Milan said.

Other opportunities for performances include working with the Lincoln City Ballet Company and Ballet Midwest, two Lincoln-based ballet companies affiliated

with UNL, and Orchestis, a group of students who are interested in dance and perform shows yearly.

Milan said she finds peoples' notions that dance is easy and separate from academics "very frustrating." Tracie Houser, a 21-year-old junior dance major from Ontario, Canada, shares Milan's views.

"You can't be a good dancer without a functioning brain," Houser said. "Maybe book-related homework is more 'heavy,' but we put in as many hours as anyone."

"Generalities," Milan said, is "a special event intended to introduce

people to modern dance, and show them how ridiculous gender myths are." Titles of pieces to be performed during the show will give people a hint of their content, she said. As examples, she mentioned "Cocktails," a piece that will be performed by men in the theater department, and "Women in White" and "Fragile Facade," both of which to be performed by women in the dance department. The program will be performed Nov. 11 and 12 at 8 p.m. in the Studio Theater on the third floor of the Temple building on 12th and R streets. General Admission is \$4.

Undergraduate program proves to be demanding
