Visas may change as graduation nears

Like most graduates of the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, Bansidhar Datta will face greater responsibilities this May.

Like other foreign students who decide to remain in the United States after graduation, Datta must update his visa in May.

Datta, a graduate student in chemistry from India, will have to change his visa so he can complete postdoctorate work in the United States.

According to Judy Wendorff, foreign students adviser, Datta's situation is not unusual among foreign students. About 20 percent of all foreign students who attend UNL end up staying in the United States, she said.

That percentage coincides with the national average, Wendorff said. As of this fall, Wendorff said,

about 1,000 foreign students are attending UNL

These students must use one of three visas to stay in the United States

upon graduation.

Fifty-five UNL foreign students are using the F-1 or J-1 visas to gain practical training in their field. The Fvisa is for students and can extend the student's stay for up to a year. The J-1 visa, for visiting exchange professors, research scholars and students. extends the stay for up to 18 months.

Students can get an extension only 'if the kind of work they're seeking is not available in their country. If it is,
