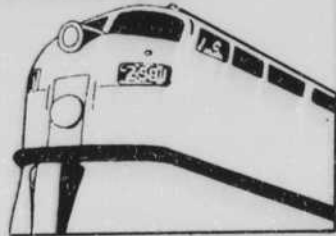
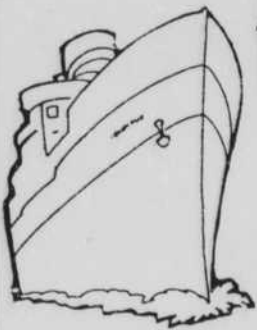

Ravnan Two perform at Kimball

The father-daughter team of pianist Audun Ravnan and cellist Kari Ravnan will perform at Kimball Recital Hall today at 8 p.m.

Audun is the George Holmes Distinguished Professor of Music and a piano department chair at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

Born in Norway, Audun graduated from Northwestern University. He specializes in music from the classical period and was the first solo artist to receive the Nebraska Governor's Arts Award.

Kari graduated from the Eastman School of Music, and is the principal cellist with the Bergen Philharmonic Orchestra.

The two are the only Nebraskan musicians accepted for the Mid-America Arts Alliance touring program.

Tonight's performance will include pieces by Shostakovich and Chopin.

David Murphy, deputy state historic preservation officer, will discuss the building traditions Czech immigrants brought to Nebraska.

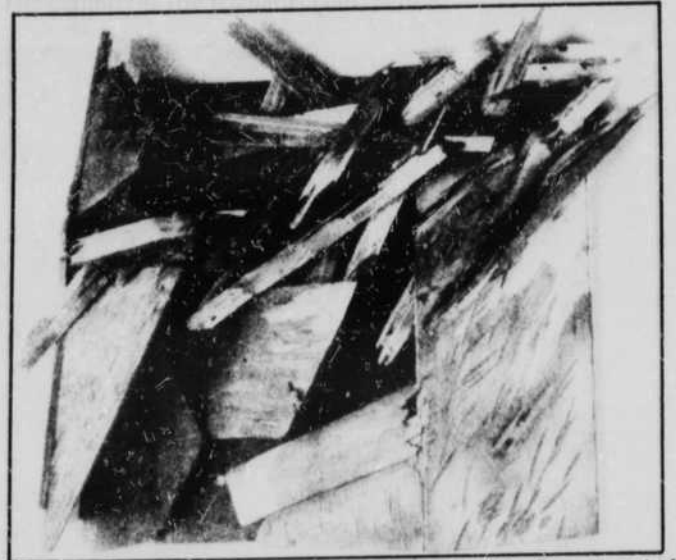
The free lecture is open to the public.

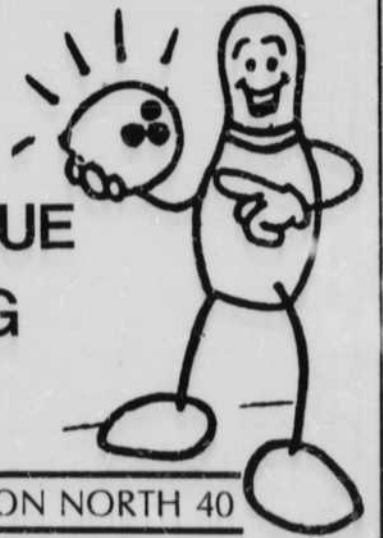
