# hnson ducks reporters as he prepares for Dallas

Departing Miami football coach limmy Johnson continued to duck reporters Sunday, saying he would hold his tongue until he actually oc-cupied the office that belonged for 29 years to Tom Landry.

At a news conference Sunday, Miami athletic director Sam Jankovich said Johnson probably will take five or six assistants with him when he becomes Dallas Cowboys coach. Included in those likely to leave were Gary Stevens, Miami's assistant head coach. Stevens wants to replace Johnson at Miami, but Jankovich said he'll conduct a national search before naming a new coach.

"Jimmy would hire me if I didn't get this job," Stevens said.

Johnson was named on Saturday to succeed L. 1dry in a transfer of ownership of the Cowboys from H.R. 'Bum' Bright to oilman Jerry Jones, a former college teammate of Johnson at Arkansas.
