Program Guidelines Discuss your course selection with your adviser to be sure it fits into your degree program. For example, Arts & Sciences students have a limit of 30 hours of Summer Reading Course and/or correspondence hours that will apply toward a degree. Check with your college's requirements before registering for a Summer Reading Course. If you are attending Teachers College, it is mandstory that you have written authorization to register for a Summer Reading Course. Note: Only two reading courses can be taken in one summer. Exceptions will require the written approval of your adviser

and/or the dean of your college. Residence roquirement

Courses with an "x" suffix do not qualify as resident credit. SRC hours will not count toward the requirement that "at least 30 of the last 36 hours of credit needed for the degree must be registered for and completed in residence."

Grading Procedures

Required work must be completed by the deadline established by your instructor. Final fall meetings are scheduled September 11-15, 1989. The nature of this contact will vary depending on the course. Your instructor will advise you of these

requirements. Pass/No Pass: Regular Pass/No Pass rules of your college will apply. Some courses have specific Pass/No Pass restrictions; please check the course listings. Final date to change to or from Pass/No Pass is July 21, 1989. Grades will be recorded by instructors on October 13, 1989.

Important: Final date to drop and have a course removed from your record is A. st 25,1989. If work is not completed and no drop is processed by the August 25th deadline, a grade of "F" will be recorded. There will be no grades of "W" or "I" given for SRC "x" classes. If you are to receive credit for a 1989 Summer Reading Course, work must be completed and graded by October 13, 1989. There will be no option to extend this deadline or reinstate your enrollment after this deadline.
