

# Jet Black Berries' new album is lousy musical venture

The simplistic chord changes, fast tempo and three to four second pauses in the music contain definite punk undertones, but it soon grows tiring. The vocals are ugly and soon turn into something like yodeling. At least it's more interesting than the

first song.

The rest of the album sounds like the first song. Some have punk undertones, some are straight knee-slapping country with a little electric guitar. It's not worth the time it takes to listen to it. It's a relief when the record is over because then it can be forgotten and the jacket can be hung on the wall.

The cover artwork really is the best part of the whole effort. It is, of course, jet black, with drawings in orange and yellow set on black background. The drawings are skeletons in traditional Mexican cowboy attire doing a dance, playing a guitar and various activities.

The titles of the drawings are single words like "Fishwalk,"

"Shadows," "Destiny" and other thought-provoking words that don't seem to have anything to do with the drawing.

It's too bad the jacket itself doesn't have anything to do with the music. The music might be interesting if it was as cool as the cover.

But it is so disappointing. Don't look here for anything new and dif-

ferent in music. This group is only on a label with innovative bands. There was nothing particularly original and it's too fast to fall asleep to, although it would be much more fulfilling to do so.

However, if blank wall space is a problem, buy this album and hang it up.
