

'Laser Fantasies' shows return to Mueller Planetarium

The laser projection system was developed by Walt Simmons, a junior engineering major at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Simmons doesn't operate the system during shows, but maintains it and receives a share of the profits,

he said.

The planetarium differs from others that present "generic" laser shows to try to please everyone in the audience, Dunn said. "They throw Blue Danube, Pink Floyd and country music at you to satisfy everybody," he said. "I don't think that works."

The laser shows at the planetarium feature only one artist or one kind of music for each 50-minute show, he said. The audience "wants to hear what they like," he said. "Rock sells more than anything else." The Mueller planetarium was

the first planetarium in the nation to use New Age, jazz and Beatles music with lasers, he said. Dunn said many people remember their childhood visits to the planetarium and don't realize it has changed with technology. Plans for the planetarium include a joint effort with a Perth,

Australia, planetarium. In that project, scientists communicating by satellite will explore the astronomy of aboriginal and modern cultures, Dunn said. New seats and a "unidirectional" screen will be installed this summer, he said.
