the tournament on Friday by defeating Tulsa 8-1, then defeated North Texas State 5-0 on Saturday before in Tulsa, Okla.

Calvin said Arkansas was more prepared to play than Nebraska. The Razorbacks sealed the victory by claiming the top five singles spots. "It's going to take more mentally and physically against teams where if takes two and a half hours for a singles match," Calvin said.
Calvin said the 80 -degree heat that boiled throughout the weekend also hurt the Huskers. The tournament marked the first time this year that Nebraska had competed outdoors.
'We weren't physically ready to play in the weather. It's hard to duplicate here," Calvin said. "But they had the same weather on their side of the court, so I don't want to use that as an excuse.
Calvin said doubles play and freshman Leslie Sue Jones shone for Nebraska. He said Nebraska' doubles teams were stronger across he board than Arkansas
Calvin said Jones, who competed at the No. 6 singles position, played steady throughout the weekend. Jones claimed Nebraska's lone victory in singles competition against Arkansas.
'She proved to the coaches and
her teammates that she could play and win at this level," he said. Calvin said the lone player to lose against Tulsa was No. 1 singles player Kathrin Edelkotter. He said Edelkotter made good shots but played erratically.

With some more experience she will get depth back on her groundstrokes, and improve her footwork," Calvin said. "She'll be back to the evel she was at last semester.

Edelkotter advanced to the quarterfinals of the Intercollegiate Tennis Coaches Association Tournament in October. She is ranked 43 rd in colle-

Calvin said Nebraska did not face

Calvin said Nebraska needs more match experience before the confer ence season begins. The Huskers wil travel to California to play five dua matches over spring break, then wil open their Big Eight season by facing lowa State.

Calvin said 9th-ranked Oklahoma State is the early favorite to capture this year's Big Eight title. He said Arkansas is at the same level as Kansas State and Oklahoma.

It's a toss-up for second place, Calvin said.
