Leading hitters for Nebraska were Ken Ramos, who went 3 for 5, Boever, who was 2 for 4, and Bruce Wobken, who was 2 for 2.

During the game, Nebraska stole nine bases, including four by Ken Ramos and three by Twitty.

Mike Zajeski, who pitched the entire game, raised his record to 2-0 with the win. Zajeski gave up four hits and two runs during seven innings while walking two and recording a career-high 10 strikeouts. Both runs against Zajeski were unearned. On Saturday, temperatures were

only in the upper-20s as Nebraska defeated Fort Hays State in the first two games of the series, 3-2 and 18-3.

In the first game Saturday, Nebraska scored the winning run on an error in the bottom of the seventh inning.

With one out, Wobken doubled down the left field line and advanced to third on a sacrifice fly by Ramos. The next batter, Twitty, hit a pop up that the Fort Hays center fielder dropped, allowing Wobken to score.

Joe Purvine, who came in to relieve Doug Tegmeier in the sixth inning, was the winning pitcher.

Purvine is now 1-0.

In the second game Saturday, Nebraska scored a season high 18 runs to back the seven-hit pitching of Pat Leinen.

Leinen, 2-1, pitched eight innings, giving up three runs, one of which was earned, while striking out four and walking six.

Offensively, Twitty led the Huskers, going 3 for 5 with 8 RBIs, two doubles, and a grand slam home run.

Nebraska also performed the first triple-play in the history of Buck Beltzer Field during the seventh in-

ning.

That play occurred when the Tigers had runners on first and second, and the Fort Hays State batter, Kelly Mulqueen, hit a line drive that was caught by shortstop Boever.

Boever then threw the ball to second baseman Wobken, who stepped on second base to double up the runner on second. Wobken then fired the ball to first baseman Twitty before the runner there could get back to the base. This completed the triple play.

Nebraska is scheduled to play a double header Wednesday at the University of Nebraska at Omaha.
