

Gymnasts register an emotional victory

An emotional victory was recorded when the Nebraska women's gymnastics team captured its third consecutive Big Eight championship.

Nebraska's Lisa McCrady said she was so pleased with the Cornhuskers' performance Saturday night in Norman, Okla., she almost broke down in tears. She said the win was important because it continued Nebraska's dominance against Oklahoma.

Nebraska recorded its 10th straight victory against the Sooners by tallying a meet-record 194.20 points. Oklahoma finished 2nd with 190.90 points, followed by Missouri with 186.50 and Iowa State with 185.65.

"I almost started crying after the

vault, because we were doing well," McCrady said. "Oklahoma is always ranked above us and we always have to prove that we're better than them. The best team definitely won."

McCrady teamed with Michele Bryant to lead Nebraska's championship charge. McCrady and Bryant tied for the meet's all-around title with 38.90 points.

Nebraska Coach Rick Walton said Bryant and McCrady split the all-around title by being consistent in all three of their events.

Bryant tied Oklahoma's Tricia Bonomo for 2nd place in the uneven bars with a 9.75 score, while McCrady tied teammate Angie Burdette and Oklahoma's Cassie Frey for 5th place with a 9.65. The event was won by Nebraska's Jane Clemons, who tallied a meet-record 9.85 score.

Bryant also won the balance beam with a 9.80, while McCrady tied

Burdette for 5th with a 9.65. McCrady edged teammates Bryant and Jeaneane Smith for 2nd in the vault with a 9.80.

Bryant and Smith tallied 9.75 scores.

"They both did a nice job. They finally put a full meet together," Walton said. "Anytime you push 39 points in the all-around, you had to do something right."

McCrady was pleased with her performance.

"Going four for four was quite an accomplishment for me. It was nice to be able to put it all together," she said. "I had been shaky on the vault, but I did a lot better this time."

Walton said he was pleased with the performance of the entire team.

"That was one of our best performances of the season," he said. "They were on top of their game.

Oklahoma competed well but we were the better team. Oklahoma was chasing us all night long and they just couldn't catch us."

McCrady said Nebraska's performance proves the Huskers aren't a fluke.

"We're for real," McCrady said. "It takes a long time to prove that you can perform, and we've done that

meet after meet."

McCrady was joined on the All-Big Eight team by Bryant, Burdette, Smith and teammates Crystal Savage, Tami Bair and Laura Saviski.

Saviski earned all-conference honors in the floor exercise, while Bair was an All-Big Eight selection in the all-around, vault and floor exercise.

Husker rugby team's match postponed

The Nebraska rugby team's match Saturday at the Great Plains Union College side championships was cancelled after five inches of snow fell in Vermillion, S.D.

Mark Palmer, the backfield captain for Nebraska, and Jim Wiggs, the scrum captain, said they were disappointed by the cancellation because it was the second postponement of the spring season.

Earlier this season, Nebraska's match against Kansas in Lawrence,

Kan., was cancelled because of wet grounds.


Nebraska was scheduled to face the winner of the South Dakota-Creighton match on Sunday. The Cornhuskers earned a first-round bye because they defeated South Dakota 18-6 and Creighton 32-0 last fall.

Palmer said he does not know when the college side championships will be held. The winner of the championships earns an automatic birth in

the regional competition on April 15 in Lawrence.

Nebraska's next match is Friday, when the Huskers face Creighton at East Campus field. The match begins at 5 p.m.
