She forces her partner-in-crime Annie Herman (Mary Gross) to join Troop Beverly Hills as an assistant against Phyllis to get her fired.

Despite its overblown, trite plot, Troop Beverly Hills' manages to create some laughs.

Long is humorous, no question, but she seems to get stuck in horrible pictures like her most recent, "Hello

This film proves no exception and traps her in an inescapable box of predictable, tired gags.

Betty Thomas' outrageous por-trayal of the demented Velda is a good supporting role. In one scene she pays homage to Robert Duvall's famous line from "Apocalypse Now" by saying, "I love the smell of cookies in the morning.
