

Stanford coach says gymnastics title is up for grabs

scores, the differences of scores make it difficult to decide," he said. The Cardinal will be coming into the meet ranked 5th (279.90), but Hamada said that his team could be one of the teams competing Friday.

"UCLA beat us five times this year. Three times I took my best team," Hamada said. "There was a 1.5 (point) difference the first time and a one-point difference the other two times."

"I feel we're a good team and are

psyched up. We will be better than we were before and we could surprise people."

Stanford is led by a trio of gymnasts, including Tim Ryan and Conrad Voorsanger, who are ranked 9th and 10th in the all-around. Scott Schaffer is 3rd on the vault with a 9.62 average.

Minnesota coach Fred Roethlisberger said his team is also well balanced. The Golden Gophers are ranked 6th with a 279.66 team scoring average.

"We have one senior and one

freshman. The remaining are juniors and sophomores," Roethlisberger

said. "They've put their heads together and have been very business-like this season. We're determined to

get into the top three. We don't have a lot of stars but we're solid from top to bottom."

Minnesota's Mark McKiernan has been a star of sorts. With a 9.73 scoring average, he is the top-ranked parallel bar performer and is coming off of a successful Big Ten championship.

Nebraska will have a shot at defending its title despite being ranked seventh with a 279.51 average. That mark is the lowest ranking of this decade.

Nebraska coach Francis Allen

said the Cornhuskers had a good practice Tuesday, their last until the meet starts.

"They looked good in practice," Allen said. "It's good to know that they're ready for the big push."

Patrick Kirksey has been the Husker's top gymnast. He is ranked 5th in the all-around (56.82), 3rd on the parallel bars (9.69), 5th on the pommel horse (9.71) and 7th on the floor exercise (9.69).

Iowa, ranked 8th, and 10th-ranked Arizona State round out the meet's field.
