

New Husker baseball coaches named

Steve Gillespie and Larry Mims have been hired to replace two Cornhusker coaches who resigned last week. Nebraska baseball coach John Sanders announced.

They replace Nebraska pitching coach Tom Pratt, who resigned to accept a high school coaching position in Prescott, Ariz., and Scott Hooper, a Husker assistant who will pursue a career in criminal justice.

Gillespie, a former baseball

coach at Fort Hays State (Kan.) University, has earned a 32-52 record during the past two seasons. Prior to taking the reins for the Tigers, he was a graduate assistant in 1987, and played for Fort Hays State in 1986.

Mims, who played his collegiate career at Nebraska, was drafted in the 16th round by the Baltimore Orioles in 1986. He moved up to the Orioles' Southern League AA club last season. During his two-year career at Ne-

braska, Mims hit .333 with 172 runs scored, 105 runs batted in, 22 doubles, 10 triples and 61 stolen bases.

Sanders said he is pleased to have the two additions to his staff.

"I'm confident they will have a positive impact on our program," he said. "We've appreciated the many contributions Tom Pratt and Scott Hooper made to our program and wish them the best in their future careers."

Nee announces schedule for men's basketball team

Seventeen home games, including five games against teams that participated in last year's NCAA Tournament, are included in Nebraska's 1989-90 men's basketball schedule.

The Cornhuskers will take the court 13 times against teams that participated in postseason games last year, meeting NCAA Tournament competitors Idaho, Creighton, Missouri, Iowa State, Oklahoma and Kansas State. Nebraska will also meet National Invitation Tournament participants Michigan State, the tournament's 4th place finisher, and Oklahoma State.

After opening the season with exhibition games against Australia's Brisbane Bullets on Nov. 10 and Athletes in Action Nov. 17, the Huskers will play Missouri-Kansas City in the season opener on Nov. 25 in the Bob Devaney Sports Center.

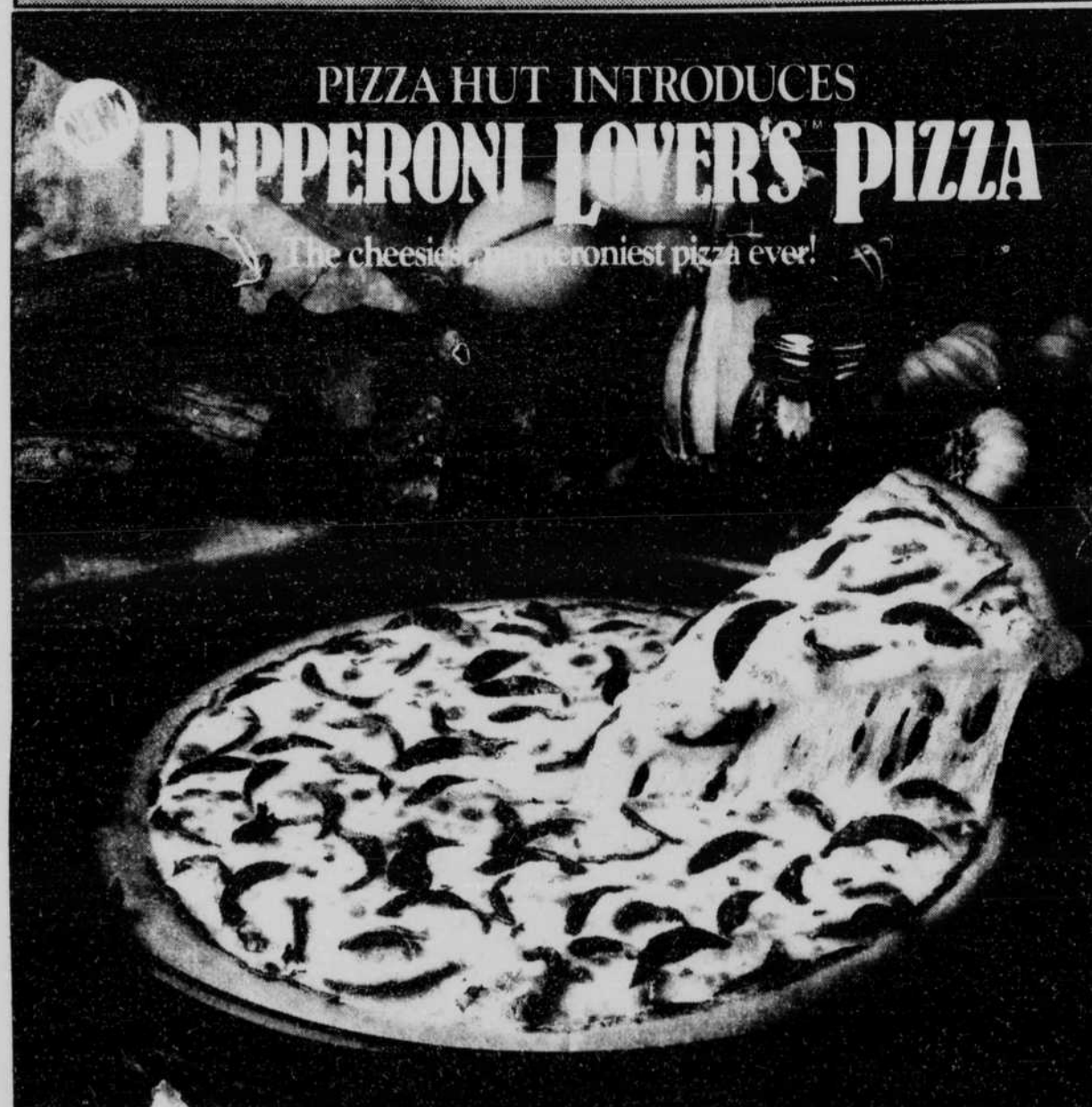
A two-game road trip to Miami

(Ohio) and Michigan State precedes the 3rd annual Ameritas Classic, Dec. 1 and 2. Nebraska, the Classic's defending champion, will play Harvard in the first round, while Air Force and Pepperdine play in the other first-round game.

Following a Dec. 5 game at Northern Illinois, the Huskers return to Lincoln for games against Texas Tech and Idaho, then travel to Omaha to face Creighton.

Nebraska will then play Wagner College and Sam Houston State before opening the Big Eight Conference schedule against Kansas Jan. 8 at the Sports Center.

"It's a solid schedule," Nebraska coach Danny Nee said. "The non-conference portion of the schedule is designed to prepare us for the Big Eight season, and I believe it does a good job of that."
