

UNL to sell old inventory items Saturday

Anyone looking for a weed-eater, lawn mower or typewriter can bid on them Saturday at a University of Nebraska-Lincoln auction.

UNL Inventory Manager Jim Sterling said "anything you can think of" will be on sale at the UNL auction, including desks, chairs, copiers and

vacuums.

Sterling said any merchandise that is broken or old is taken to the inventory department, where it may be recycled by being given to another department. Items sold at the auction could not be recycled, he said.

Auctions are held every three to four months and can bring in up to \$10,000 on a good day, Sterling said. Part of the money from the auction

covers the payroll for the inventory employees, Sterling said. The auction company, Ficke & Ficke of Lincoln, receives 5 percent of the profits and the rest of the money goes toward classroom furniture and any expenses the inventory department incurs, he said.

The auction starts at 9 a.m. in East Campus warehouse No. 1.

or produce:

(1) obscene or indecent materials, including, but not limited to, depictions of sadomasochism, homo-eroticism, the exploitation of children, or individuals engaged in sex acts; or

(2) material which denigrates the objects or beliefs of the adherents of a particular religion or non-religion; or

(3) material which denigrates, debases, or reviles a person, group, or class of citizens on the basis of race, creed, sex, handicap, age, or national origin."

Kay Kubicek, director of the Lincoln Arts Council, said that because of the vague and extensive wording of the Helms measure, practically any artwork could be found offen-

sive.

Kubicek said the amendment not only touches upon the visual arts, such as painting and sculpture, but also reaches out to poetry, dance and music.

"I think that the NEA is going to be in serious trouble if the Jesse Helms attitude prevails," she said.
