That would result in a savings of more than \$1,000, he said.

Recycling also could save UNL money by reducing the amount of garbage it sends to the landfill, which would reduce tipping fees, Burger

UNL paid \$21,935.40 in tipping fees last year to dispose of 5,511,300 tons of garbage, he said.
