Fun-filled show comes to Lincoln

An American stage production that has been touring worldwide since 1982, including recent performances in the Soviet Union, is making a stop in Lincoln this week. "Toymaker's Dream," which features more than \$250,000 in lights, sound and computerized fireworks, will be performed tonight and Wednesday at Nebraska Wesleyan University. The show is a blend of dance, pantomime, acrobatics and digitally mastered music highlighting an allegory of a toymaker and his son. The 30 cast and crew members just have returned to the United States from their second tour of the Soviet Union. More than 75,000 Soviet citizens attended the performances in

Moscow, Minsk, Kiev and Odessa. Two of the performers are from Nebraska: Jeff Morrow of Lincoln and Michelle DeLong of Beaver Crossing. The show will take the stage at 7:30 p.m. in O'Donnell Auditorium on the Wesleyan campus. Tickets are available at Maranatha Christian Supply, 1265 S. Cotner St. Advance ticket prices are \$2 and \$3 at the door.
