A Grammy-Award-winning jazz group, the Yellowjackets, will perform two shows Sunday at Omaha's Ranch Bowl Entertainment Center.

The Yellowjackets won the 1989 Jazz Fusion Grammy for "Politics." The group also won a 1986 R&B Instrumental Performance Grammy for its 1986 release, "Shades." The band's new album, released by MCA records, is "The Spin," an album group members call their most traditional jazz al-

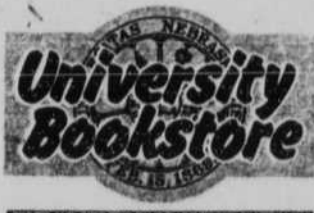
