cient in all styles, Milan said.
"The type of degree received depends on the particular school," she said. "We have training in all areas of dance and a student may decide on an area of concentration.

It's important for a dancer to be proficient in all areas because professional dance companies are no longer students at UNL -- a bachelor of fine as segregated in particular dance styles as they used to be, Milan said.

As in all the performing arts areas, it's important for university dance programs to have faculty with professional dance experience. Milan said UNL'has a very good mix of experi-


