The opening track "Aggravation" is a fast, hook-filled song with lyrical content unlike the traditional Kinks. The overall mood of the song is very gloomy and hopeless. It reflects life in the fast-paced, confusing, and cruel world that has been commonplace to most people throughout the 1980s.

The title track "UK Jive" reflects the pop side of the Kinks. It is very smooth, upbeat and extremely danceable. "UK Jive" will more than likely have some chart value in Lon-don dance clubs and fits well with English top ten.


'Entertainment'' opens side two and is in itself a blatant contradiction. The lyrics comment about the substandard entertainment industry while this song is a very poor example
