of Students for the Right to Vote, said the organization is waiting for clarification of the student trustees' voting status before taking any action.

Wickless, also the president of the Residence Hall Association, said students should have a vote in decisions concerning them.

"Education of students is the primary concern (of governing bodies), and they should have a say in their education," he said.

Russ Johnson, chairman of Students for the Right to Vote, said he is in favor of the proposal because decentralizing higher education government would benefit students.

Johnson said he believes "the decentralized governing body will be able to react more directly to students' needs."

The proposal will be either widely accepted or rejected, he said, and student response will have an impact on the outcome of the proposal.

Students for the Right to Vote has a network of student leaders and will be concentrating on generating student enthusiasm for the proposal, Johnson said.

He said the organization plans to write a letter in support of the recommendation, signed by various student leaders, and send it to Nebraska newspapers.

Fiddelke said she expects ASUN to present a bill supporting the consulting firm's recommendations.

ASUN also will urge support for the proposal by other governing bodies, Bohling said.

Wickless said he hopes similar legislation will be introduced in the RHA senate.

Because officials in the consulting firm are experts in education, Johnson said, the report is designed to provide the state with a more efficient education system.

"Students will get a better education in the long run," he said.

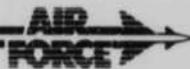
