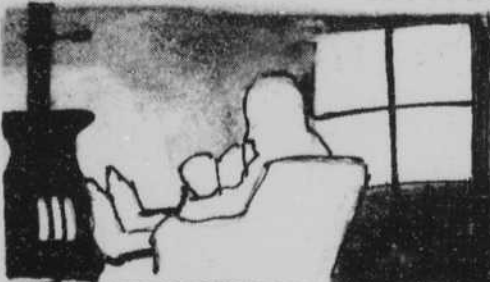


S. Claus
