Team heading for Colorado

NU women hope for road win

Nebraska women's basketball coach Angela Beck said she sees her team's determination to win.

The determination just hasn't shown up on the scoreboard lately.

The Cornhuskers opened their Big Eight season by dropping a pair of road contests last week. Nebraska opened Big Eight play by losing a 71-60 decision to Kansas, and a 67-62 contest to Missouri.

Against Missouri on Saturday, a malfunctioning Nebraska offense allowed the Tigers to jump to an early lead.

"It was weird," Beck said. "We didn't connect on the shots and didn't get any second shots."

But the Huskers came back. Down 37-31 at halftime, Beck said she thought her team could win. The game stayed close the rest of the way, and the Huskers even had the ball in

the last minute.

"They showed they wanted to win," Beck said. "They didn't want just to stay close."

The Huskers shot 52 percent from the field against Missouri. Ann Halsne led Nebraska with 16 points and nine rebounds. The junior post player also led the Huskers with 15 points against Kansas.

The team's other three-year veteran returned in the Missouri game. Kelly Hubert, who suffered a serious ankle injury Dec. 5 against Oral Roberts, tallied 14 points and five rebounds in her first game back.

"It shocked us," Beck said.

The coach said team trainer Julie Buck was skeptical about the return. After a break-away layup, though, they knew the junior power forward would be all right, Beck said.

With the losses to Kansas and Missouri and a 93-69 blitzing by Northern Illinois at home, the 8-7 Huskers have swung from a four-

game winning streak to a three-game skid.

During Dead Week, the Huskers beat Wichita State, 82-72. Nebraska won the first three games over the holiday break, topping Northern Iowa, 80-48, Drake, 76-64, and Creighton, 103-77.

Although Nebraska is at the bottom of the conference, Beck said she saw some good from the two defeats away from home.

"We put ourselves in a situation to win it on the road," she said.

Beck said she and Missouri coach Joann Rutherford talked about the conference race, and both agreed a 9-5 or 8-6 record will win the title. That's seven home wins, plus one or two victories on the road.

Nebraska has one more chance to steal a road win before returning to the Bob Devaney Sports Center. The Huskers play at Colorado on Wednesday, then play Oklahoma State in Lincoln Saturday afternoon.

could win it were the 15 with the team. But it was tough getting that close, thinking we had won, and then being told that we didn't."

The Huskers declined to wrestle Iowa State in the consolation round, and the Cyclones wrestled Iowa for third place, losing 24-13.

Nebraska defeated No. 18-ranked Clemson 34-10 and Virginia 49-3 on Tuesday.

Neumann said Nebraska's success

during the holiday break didn't surprise him.

"After the Las Vegas Invitational earlier this year (in which Nebraska finished third), it showed where we stand with other teams," Neumann said. "Everyone on this team knows what they're capable of doing."

Nebraska's next meet is against No. 12-ranked Notre Dame Saturday at the Bob Devaney Sports Center. The meet starts at 7:30 p.m.
