is clean and clear throughout the song and has a very steady, semimonotonous drumbeat behind it.

What makes this song great is the sound of Murphy's voice. In this tune, Murphy sings with an organ-sounding harmony that blends perfectly with the music.

Another song that helps make this album Murphy's best and most interesting solo work is "Marlene

Dietrich's Favourite Poem." As the title might indicate, Murphy is sort of half singing, half reciting poetry.

The music is strange and slow. It sounds like something you would hear from a very depressed Spanish musician in a bar -- a new and interesting sound.

"Deep" provides a classic, New Age-sound combined with some unique, unexpected, and well orchestrated sounds.

This is Murphy at his best.


