### Jazz tribute at Kimball Hall on Saturday

Three renowned jazz artists will join musical forces at 8 p.m. tomorrow to pay tribute to jazz legend Benny Goodman.

Soloist Buddy DeFranco, guitarist Herb Ellis and vibraphone player Terry Gibbs will be accompanied by the Russ Long Trio at Kimball Recital Hall at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

Regarded as one of the most imaginative clarinetists today, DeFranco has won 20 awards from Downbeat Magazine. He has made concert and recording appearances with greats Billie Holiday, Nat "King" Cole, Charlie Parker, Dizzy Gillespie, Stan Getz and others.

Ellis has performed with the Jimmy Dorsey Band, the Oscar Peterson Trio and has toured with the group Jazz at the Philharmonic.

Gibbs has played with greats Buddy Rich, Benny Goodman and the Woody Herman Orchestra.

A pre-performance talk about the musical style of Benny Goodman is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. in room 119 of the Westbrook Music Building.

Tickets are \$13 and \$9, and half-price for UNL students and persons 18 and under.
