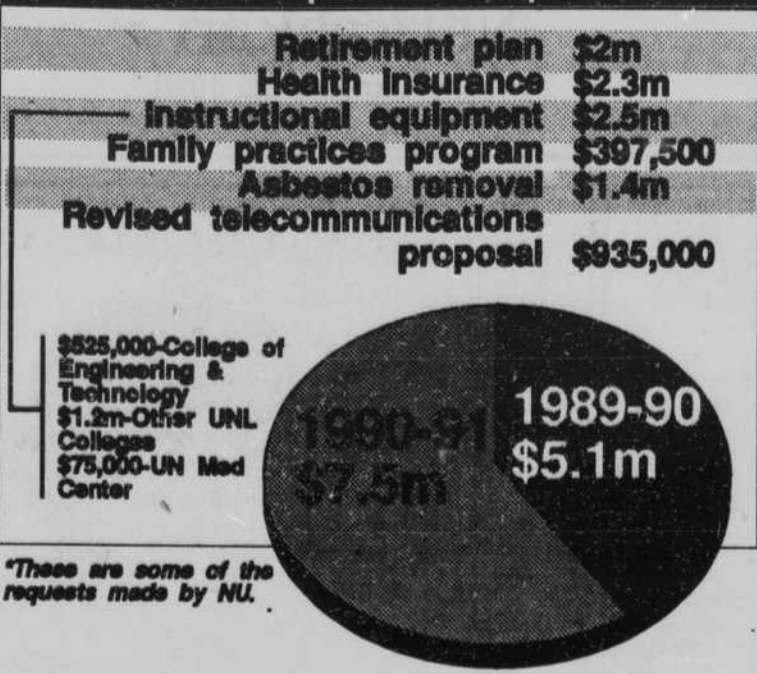


Cost of unexpected expenditures

"You can't get into that trap of continually finding funds," Blank said. "It's kind of an around-and-around-we-go situation."

Sen. Lorraine Langford of Kearney also questioned the \$3.5 million request for unanticipated costs in the retirement plan.

Part of the request includes a .5 percent increase in the university's contribution to the retirement fund.

Langford said that granting such a request "puts the state in a very bad position" because state colleges also would want an increase.

Massengale and Blank said the half-percent increase already went into effect. If the university had not misjudged the original amount needed to sustain the retirement program, Massengale said, it would not be requesting additional money.

About \$3.3 million for the health-care program also is requested because of a 24 percent increase in claims in 1989.

"It seems that no matter how pes-

simistic the nation's projections are for rising health-care costs, the results seem always to be even worse," Blank said.

Massengale said the fluctuation in claims makes it difficult to estimate the university's needs.

"... increases of this magnitude seriously strain our ability to cover claims."

Massengale said employee-paid premium rates were raised by more than 35 percent, which was "as far as we felt we could go and be fair to our employees."

The university also is requesting \$386,000 in 1989-90 and \$397,500 for 1990-91 for the family practice program at the Lincoln Medical Education Foundation.

About \$1.4 million is requested for asbestos removal in Burnett Hall. Today, the Appropriations Committee will hear a request for \$935,000 for a telecommunications system for all three campuses.

Warner said the committee probably will decide in late February what university budget allocations to propose to the Legislature.
