can't understand you, God can. Brown rewards that faith by picking up a piece of chalk with his foot and writing "Mother" on the floor. By this point, Brown's family --

Before long, with the help of a doctor named Eileen Cole, Brown's family is able to understand him. With the speech therapy that Cole gives her friends, neighbors and even her him, Christy is able to speak more

clearly. People are able to understand him, and become a little less afraid of

Cole even helps Brown put on an exhibit of his work, and Brown experiences emotions of love and denial when he falls in love with Cole.

Daniel Day-Lewis is excellent as Brown. When watching him live the character of Brown, it is easy to forget that it isn't the real Christy Brown on the movie screen.

He is brilliant at reminding the audience that, while cerebral palsy

victims may have body parts that do not work perfectly, they still have very real emotions and feelings.

Brenda Fricker is his mother, the only person who believes in him at first. Fricker is inspiring as Mrs. Brown. Her strong belief in her son is touch-




