**Exxon announces innocent plea to five-count criminal indictment**

ANCHORAGE, Alaska - Exxon announced Monday that it would plead innocent to a five-count criminal indictment charging it with negligence and other crimes in the nation's worst oil spill a year ago.

The grounding of the tanker Exxon Valdez "was tragic, but it was an accident," the company said in a prepared statement announcing its intended plea.

On Feb. 27, a federal grand jury handed up a five-count criminal indictment against the company stemming from the oil spill, which occurred after the Exxon Valdez slammed into a charted reef on March 24, 1989, in Prince William Sound.

The spill of nearly 11 million gallons of North Slope crude oil coated hundreds of miles of coastline and killed uncounted numbers of fish, birds and other marine life.

Exxon said it would vigorously defend itself against the charges, which include violating clean water and refuse acts, and negligently and unlawfully discharging oil into a navigable waterway.

Capt. Joseph Hazelwood, the Exxon Valdez skipper, was convicted last month on a single charge of negligently discharging oil but was acquitted on three other counts.

More than 160 civil suits are pending against Exxon by the state of Alaska, environmentalists and private individuals.

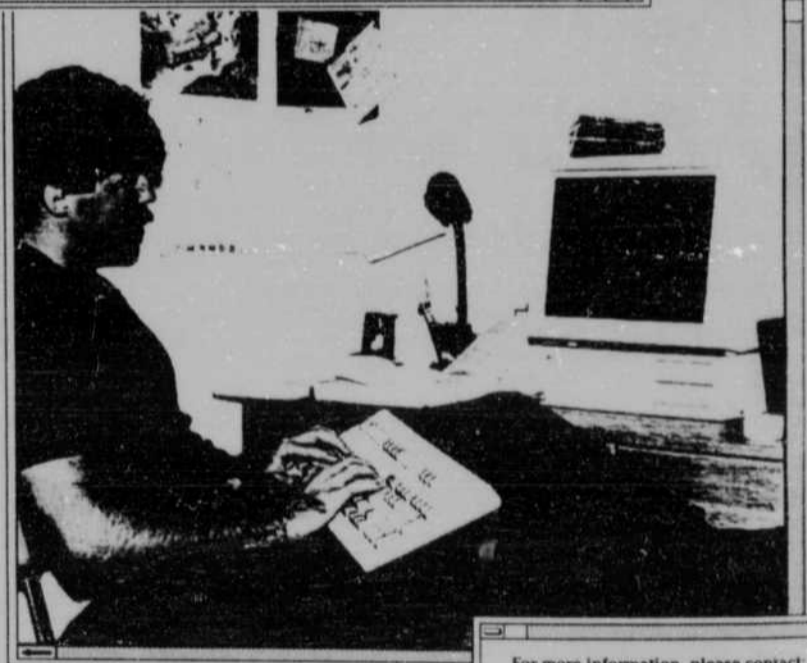
