But for all the fury of his studio efforts like "Texas Flood" and "Couldn't Stand the Weather," nothing could come close to the energy of his live shows, which have been known to last as long as six hours.

This was made clear in 1986, with the release of "Live Alive," a double-length LP that solidified Vaughan's mainstream popularity.

"In Step" took home a Grammy for best blues album of 1989, and if

anything, represents a return to the barroom blues found on "Texas Flood."

As for Jimmie Vaughan, who hasn't exactly faded away himself, he is nothing but graceful about his brother's rise to guitar demigod status.

"It's almost as if, being the little brother, he had to prove he could play better than me," said the Fabulous Thunderbirds guitarist. "Well, he sure did that."

Tickets for Stevie Ray Vaughan and Double Trouble are still available at Pickles Records. Ticket price for the 7:30 p.m. show is \$18.50.

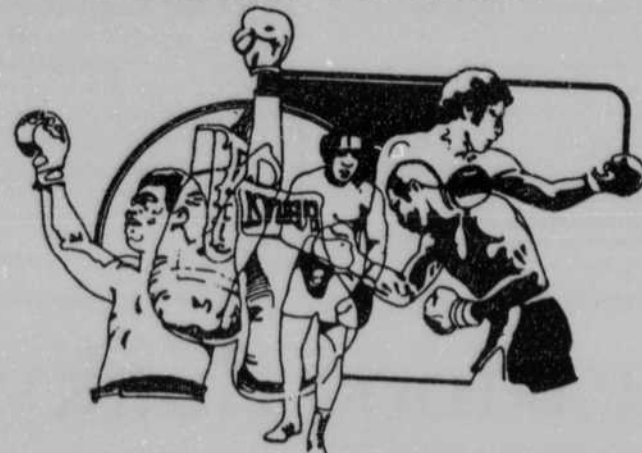
