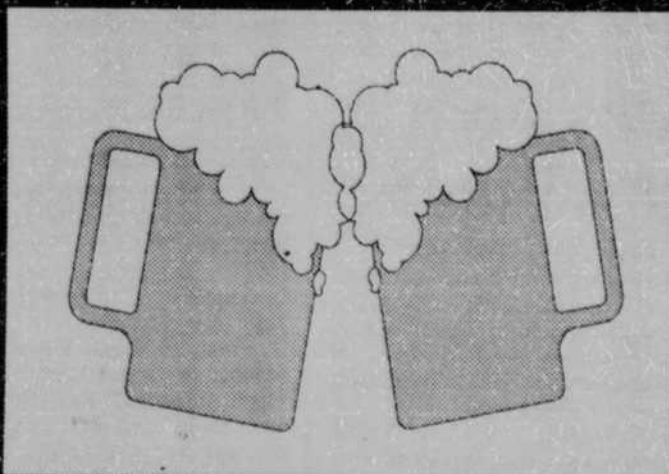

NATA inducts physical trainer to Hall of Fame

The chief physical therapist at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Student Health Center was inducted into the National Athletic Trainers' Association Hall of Fame at this year's annual banquet in Indianapolis.

Roland E. "Duke" LaRue, who also is director of the UNL athletic training curriculum, was one of four inductees this year. He has been at UNL for 12 years.

LaRue, who has been a member of the NATA for 33 years, said he was "thrilled to death" to be chosen by his peers as a recipient of the honor.

He said he knew six weeks in advance that he would receive the award. He spent that time "thinking about what worthy, choice words" he would use for his acceptance speech, he said.

"It's always something you dream about," LaRue said. "To a guy who always goes to the annual banquet and sees others being awarded and saying, 'Those are great people,' ... someday you hope you'll be there. It's quite an honor, I feel."

LaRue, who has served as a trainer at the 1972 and 1980 Olympic Games, said he placed the plaque where he can stare at it, the award that recognizes him for his distinction and commitments, every time he uses his phone.

He is the third UNL physical trainer to get the award. George F. Sullivan, the athletic department's head trainer, and the late Paul J. Schneider also received the award.
