Variations" was performed at the convention.

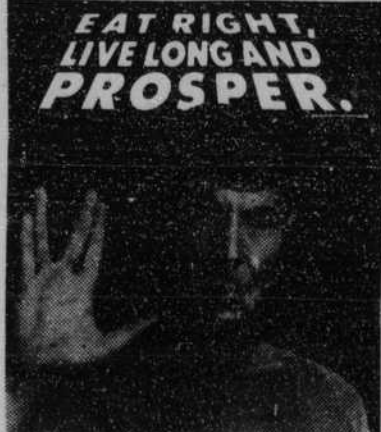
And the original play, "A Crowded House," by UNL student Heather Flood, currently is being considered for national play writing awards.

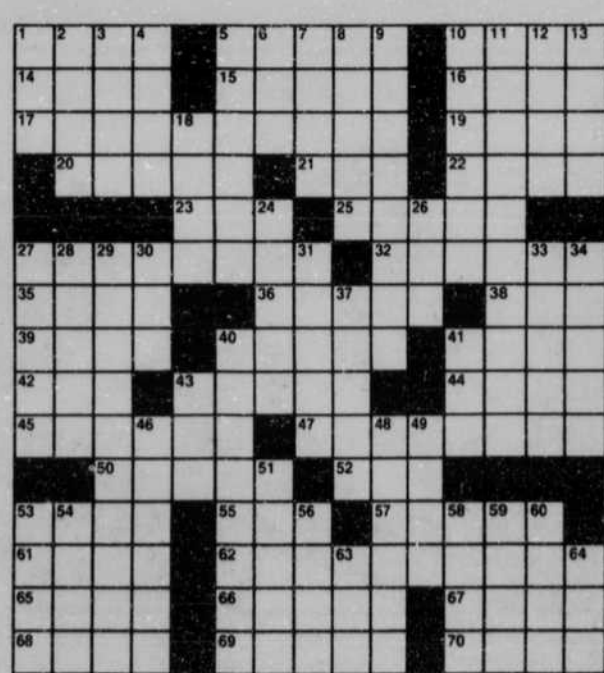
